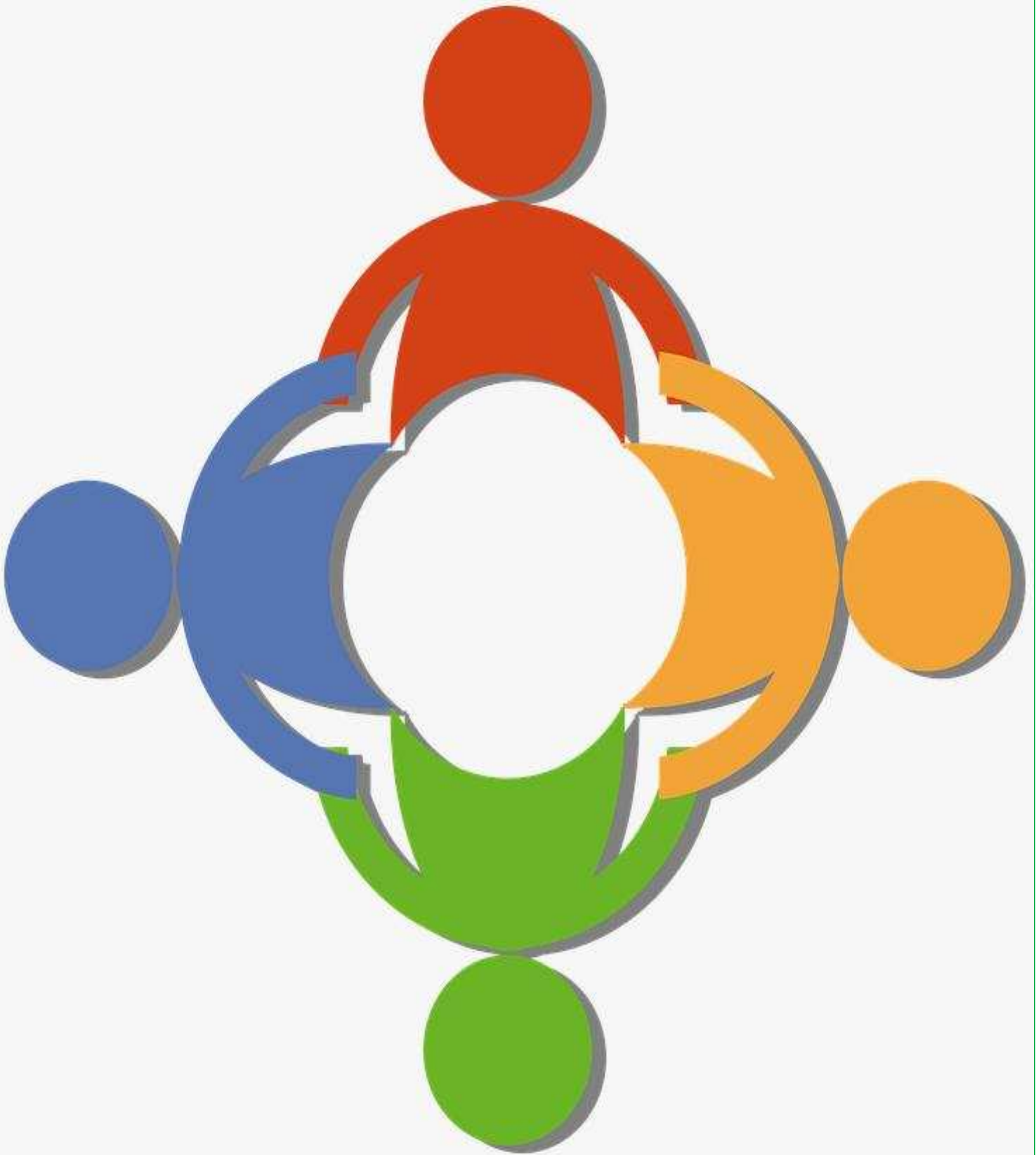
Background and Introduction:

Swat Relief Initiative, Inc., is a US 501 (c) 3 non-profit corporation, Registered in Delaware, USA & Swat Relief Initiative (Pak) is a subchapter of Swat Relief Initiative, Inc., USA registered with registered with the Directorate of Social welfare, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan under the Voluntary Social Welfare agencies (Registration & Control) Ordinance 1961 (XLVI of 1961) and Khyber Pakhtukhwa Charity Commission under section 6 (b) read with Section 12 & 14 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Charities Act, 2019 . SRI is a unique organization founded by Zebunisa Arshad Jilani, granddaughter of the last Ruler of Swat, and her husband Arshad Jilani. SRI was created as a platform for all sincere philanthropists to come together as volunteers to help the poor through long term, low cost, sustainable programs in Education, Healthcare, Economic Empowerment, Clean Water and Community Development, which encourage independence and self-reliance for those who have no hope.

Swat Relief Initiative (SRI) strives to improve the lives of women and children in Pakistan (Swat) through healthcare, education, economic growth and a sustainable environment. This non-profit organization also empowers societies through community development, social mobilization and awareness programs to help them achieve a better quality of life.

From 2008 to 2010, the Swat Valley in Pakistan had three major successive catastrophes. It began with a brutal Taliban takeover, followed by a massive refugee crisis during the resulting military conflict, and finally a devastating flood that brought further chaos to the region. This **short video** outlines the creation of SRI and some of our relief efforts relating to these disasters.

The people of Swat are still suffering in the aftermath of these events, which caused massive destruction of infrastructure and human life. While SRI started off as a relief organization, we have now transitioned into community development and have created programs designed to strengthen society and benefit the people of Swat. Our focus is on helping women and children — the most vulnerable and disadvantaged segments of society.

Preventive Health Care Program

In order to keep the importance of good health in mind, the project was started with the establishment of a Community Health Center in Swat. More than 2,000 households were covered for preventative and curative health services through this CHC. The service encompasses providing comprehensive community educational services, infant immunization, TT vaccination for women, growth monitoring for children, pre-postnatal care to pregnant women and medical camps.

The Preventive Health Care program was initiated with the technical support and collaboration of Human Development Foundation (HDF) , who is providing SRI administrative and technical support in how to implement the program in a better and sophisticated manner.

The project was implemented through Health and Social Mobilization Team by raising awareness against different out breaking diseases such as diarrhea, Cholera, TB, Typhoid, Dengue and malaria and how to prevent oneself from such diseases.

The project baseline was held in 2010-2011 to set the baseline values against the various indicators against the set goals/objectives of the project. In 2017-2018, the mid-term evaluation survey was held to measure the impact of the project activities over a period of seven years.

The Mid-Term Evaluation Survey has designed and initiated by Performance Improvement Program (PIP) of HDF. Project staff was involved and a team of enumerators was also hired locally for the survey.

Education

While keeping in line with its Objectives by putting maximum children to schools, SRI had extended its channel of facilitating more and more kids to have an easy and doorstep access to quality education. By persuing this SRI had join hands with its partners to further enhance the infrastructure of the community Schools build at far flung villages of District swat .

The Community Model School Gato Sar was extended to further addition of 3 rooms in the year 2019, which aims at providing facility to further students to get basic primary education.

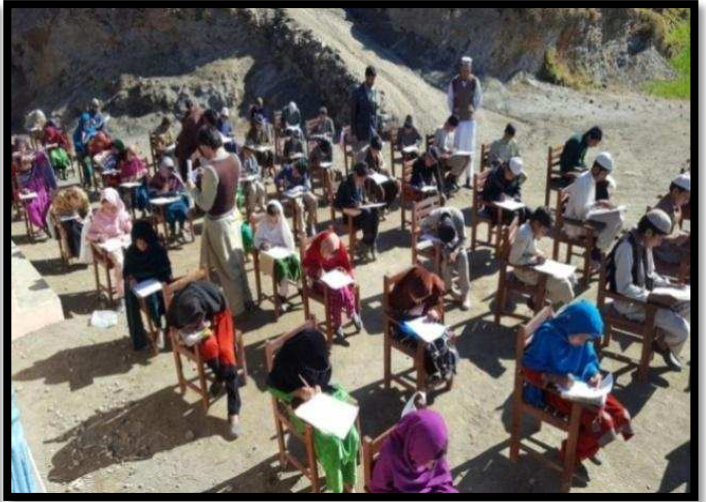
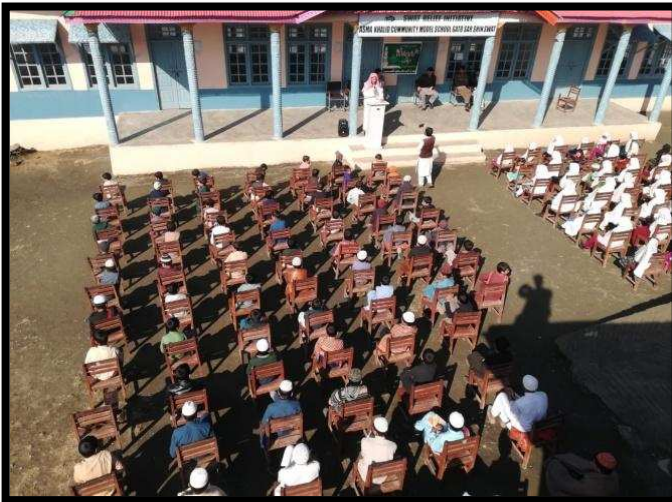

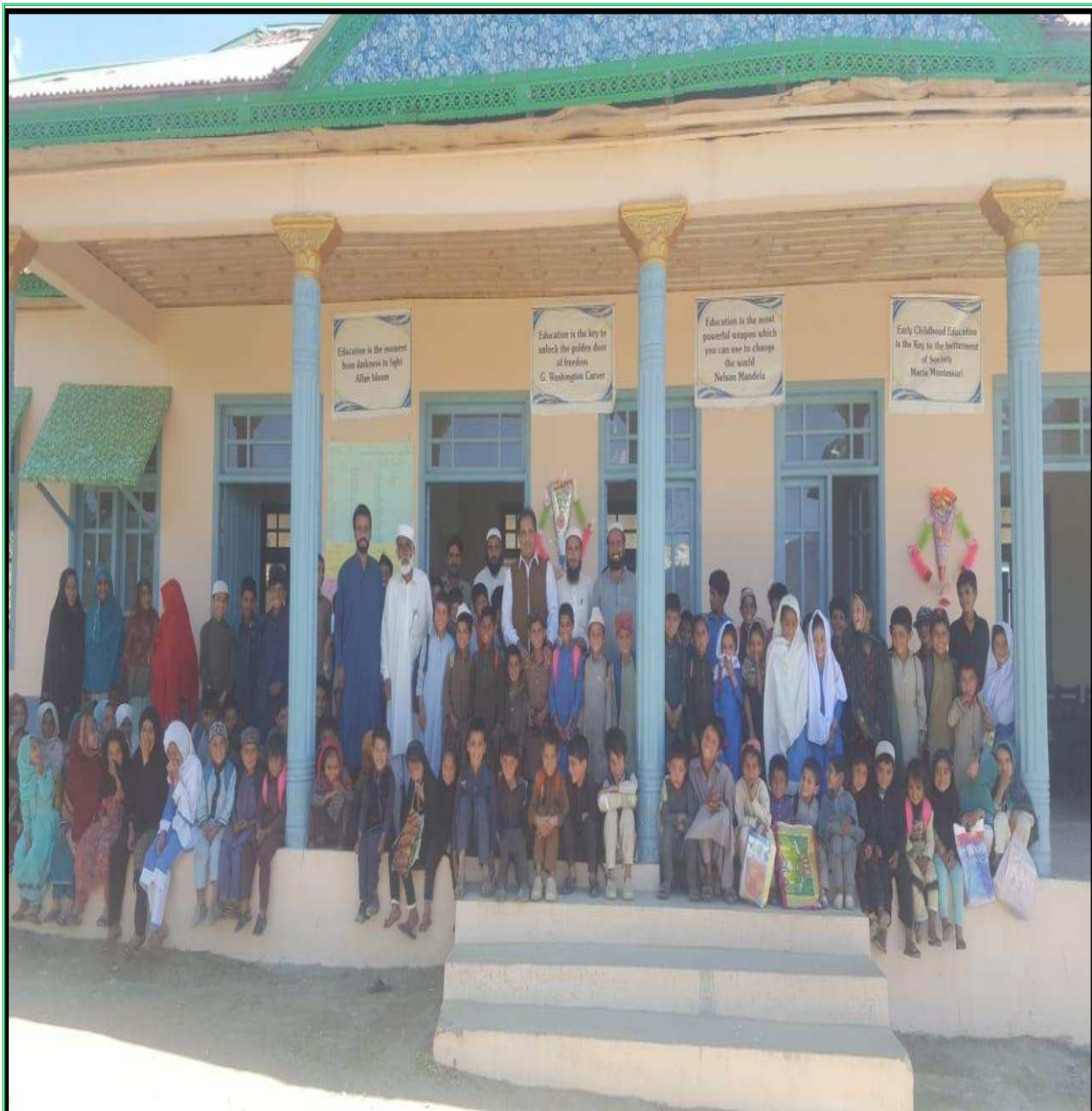
